

## **HANDOUT #4 – QUALIFICATION COURSE FOR PRIVATE SECURITY SHOTGUN (SPOs #6 – #8/PPT #40)**

Instructor note: The course of fire has not changed from the 1998 version that was being used previously

**SPO #6** – Using a pump action shotgun loaded with 3 rounds buckshot, placed in Condition 3, at a distance of 20 feet, the student will, starting from the carrying ready position and on command, fire 1 round into the target and return to the ready position. This is repeated 3 times for a total of 3 rounds, attaining a score of 100%

**SPO #7** – Using a pump action shotgun loaded with 3 rounds of buckshot, placed in Condition 3, at a distance of 20 feet, the student will, starting from the carrying ready position and on command, fire 1 round into each of the 3 targets within an overall time of 4 seconds, attaining a score of 100%

**SPO #8** – Using a pump action shotgun loaded with 2 rounds of buckshot, placed in Condition 3, the student will, on command, move to the 6'x4' barricade (located 30 feet from the start line), and, fire 1 round into each of the 2 dominant side targets (located 20 feet from the barricade), within an overall time limit of 15 seconds and maintaining proper cover, attaining a score of 100%
